Volunteers of Mesa County Fire Authority,

It is our intent to limit the potential for work-related injuries. However, despite our best efforts, injuries may still occur. In order to assure that the best possible care is available for injuries you may sustain while performing job duties with Mesa County Fire Authority, we have chosen *St. Mary's Occupational Health System*. This clinic is qualified in treating occupational injuries and illnesses. Volunteers must obtain treatment for work-related injuries and illnesses from the above mentioned medical care provider.

If you believe you were injured while performing job duties with the Mesa County Fire Authority, notify the Chief immediately. He will see that you receive the care your injuries require.

In the event of a life or limb threatening emergency, you will be taken to the nearest or most appropriate emergency care facility. Follow-up care if needed will be provided by the medical care provider designated above.

I have read and am fully aware of this policy regarding medical treatment for work-related injuries and illnesses and agree to seek medical treatment for these injuries from the medical provider listed above.
